

Day 4: The Power of Confession Guide

Focus: Confessing Gods word daily

2 Corinthians 4:13

It is written: “I believed; therefore I have spoken.” Since we have that same spirit of faith, we also believe and therefore speak.

Lesson Activity

- Write down a few things in your life that you believe God for. For example; if you're Mother or Father is sick and you want God to heal them write it down. Another example if you are trying out for a football team or volleyball team and you need God to help you, so that you can make the team, write it down for now.
- Next find scriptures that relate to what it is that you believe God for.
- Ask a guardian (Parent, Pastor or counselor) for help in finding those scriptures.
- Write down those scriptures.
- After you have read those scriptures, place the list somewhere safe, and confess these things aloud daily.
- It is one thing to believe God's word, but you must also confess his word.
- Don't give up Cadet, trust God, and walk in Faith until you see God move on your behalf.

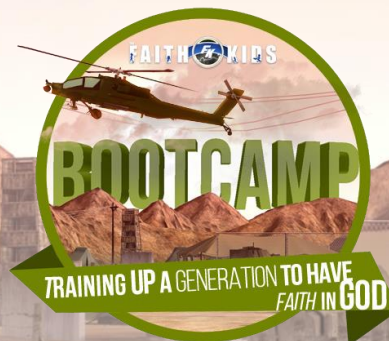
